In the mid-1950s, residents of the eastern neighborhoods of Indianapolis envisioned a medical facility that would provide easier access to quality health care services. That dream launched a grass roots effort of local volunteers who began door-to-door solicitation of contributions from businesses and private individuals in the area. In what came

to be known as “the swiftest, most effective fund raising campaign of our time,” the dream of those visionaries was realized with the opening of Community Hospital on 16th Street and Ritter Avenue in 1956. The pride of that local effort more than a half century ago remains evident today among the many residents who can say “I helped build this hospital.”

Over the years, Community Hospital has evolved into Community Health Network, a leading not-for-profit health system, offering convenient access to expert physicians, advanced treatments, and leading edge technology. One of the state’s largest health care networks, Community today lists five hospitals, outpatient surgery facilities, MedCheck walk-in care clinics and more than 90 sites of care, focusing on enhancing the health and well-being of residents across Central Indiana. Network-wide, it employs more than 11,000 health care professionals and more than two thousand medical staff members.

COMMUNITY IN CARMEL

Pursuant to its mission of providing a complete range of health care services and enhancing the well-being of individuals in the Central Indiana area, Community Health Pavilion Carmel opened in 2002. The Carmel pavilion has primary care physicians and specialists, including a Med-Check walk-in care center that is open every day. In addition, other medical services, such as an imaging center, physical therapy, and a sleep/wake disorder center, are all available at the pavilion. “One of our goals is to increase health care access and convenience for our patients right in their own neighborhoods,” said Jon Fohrer, CEO of Community’s ambulatory care division. “The Carmel pavilion provides this one-stop access to an array of care and services.”

Community Hospital North has served the Carmel residents and surrounding areas since 1985. The network has more than 500 integrated physicians, including

specialists who have become recognized leaders in the field of robotic surgery. Community Hospital North provides premier services in acute care, including orthopedics and joint replacement, neurosciences, children’s health, women’s health and surgical care. Community North is well-recognized for its maternity care, excellent birthing experience, and has one of the largest neonatal intensive care units in the nation. Community’s Behavioral Health is Central Indiana’s largest behavioral health provider, with an inpatient pavilion and crisis center located on the Community Hospital North campus, and six outpatient offices across four counties. In addition, Behavioral Health recently opened LifeCheck,

The Healthy Hearts Center offers the residents of Carmel and surrounding areas regular heart healthy screening events and education throughout the year. It hosts a variety of services and programs through its accredited chest pain center, diagnostic catheterization, interventional cardiology, electrophysiology, vascular surgery, open heart surgery, non-invasive diagnostic testing, and advanced imaging and pharmacy services.
