leadership opportunities, and community involvement, have helped establish Baylor's reputation as one of the premier independent co-educational day and boarding schools in the United States.



"Our success is best illustrated by our graduating classes," states Barbara Kennedy, the school's Associate Vice President, External Affairs. "We send one hundred percent of our students to colleges and universities, a great majority of whom are accepted into their first university of choice. Our most recent senior class earned college scholarships totaling \$10.8 million and our graduates have received \$32 million in college scholarships over the last four years. During that same time period, forty-seven graduates earned athletic scholarships."
